

Bacterial Meningitis Notification and Acknowledgment of Receipt of Health Information

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board requires that each institution make available to students information concerning Bacterial Meningitis. In addition the state requires all college students under the age of 22 who are new or newly returning to any Texas institution of higher education to submit proof of having received a bacterial meningococcal vaccination sometime in the past 5 years and at least 10 days before beginning classes.

Please read Bacterial Meningitis information and related forms and sign below to confirm you have received them. Return this acknowledgement to admissions@diu.edu as soon as possible. Dallas Int'l Univ. is required to keep this confirmation in your file for two years.
